Elby Iris Colón, 68, New Britain, passed away on November 19, 2018 surrounded by her loving daughters. Born in Manhattan, NY, daughter of the late Edelmiro and Gracia (Caban) Colón, Elby has been a New Britain resident since 1970. She was employed at the Hospital For Special Care for 32 years, retiring in 2017.

Elby was a matriarch devoted to her family and best known for casting her net of love far and wide.
