Eleanor Platush Nelson, 80, of New Britain, wife of Allen E. Nelson, died Sunday October 14, 2007 at her home surrounded by her loving family. A lifelong New Britain resident, she was a graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1944 and was a member of her Class Reunion Committee. Eleanor formerly worked in the Tax Collectors office at the New Britain City Hall for 10 years and later in the accounts payable department at CCSU for 12 years, retiring in 1987.
