



Elizabeth "Betty" Berry

June 9, 1930 - June 17, 2007

Elizabeth "Betty" Berry, 77, of Berlin, died Sunday June 17, 2007 at the Hospital of Central CT in New Britain. A New Britain native and longtime resident, daughter of the late Carl and Bertha Danielson Berry, she lived in Berlin since 2002. Betty was a graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1948, and from the Hartford Hospital School of Nursing. As an RN, she served with the US Navy Nurse Corps during the Korean Conflict and later spent five years with Project Hope in several foreign countries. She received her Masters Degree from Columbia University in New York City and also taught nursing at Wayne State University in Detroit for two years. Betty later worked at Elm Hill Nursing Center in Rocky Hill for 20 years, retiring in 1995. Betty's interests included sports, music, art and bridge. She was a member of the Rocky Hill Congregational Church, the Hillside Garden Club, the Berlin Seniors and was a former member of AARP.

Surviving is a brother, Daniel Berry and his wife Betty of Lady Lake, FL; a sister, Norma Wallace of Kensington; four nieces and four nephews.

A memorial service will be held Saturday 10 AM at Carlson Funeral Home, 45 Franklin Square, New Britain. Burial will follow in Fairview Cemetery.
