Elizabeth Schroeder Bishop, 82, of Berlin died Friday April 11, 2003 at her home. Wife of the late Edward H. Bishop Biskupiak who passed in 1973, she was born in Berlin and was a Berlin resident most of her life. Elizabeth helped run a family business Bishop's Garage in Cromwell with her husband and sons until her retirement in 1996. Elizabeth was a member of Berlin Congregational Church.
