Elizabeth "Betty" Eshia Furlong, 85, of New Britain, passed away Wednesday February 20, 2008 at Hospital of Central Connecticut in New Britain. A native and longtime New Britain resident, she graduated from New Britain High School in 1940, served with the Navy Waves during World War II and graduated from the Stamford, CT School of Nursing.
