Elizabeth Rota Romegialli, 83, of East Berlin, wife of Bruno Romegialli, died Sunday October 6, 2002 at her home. Born in Middletown, she lived in East Berlin most of her life. She was a cafeteria worker for the Berlin Board of Education at both Percival and Hubbard Schools for over 10 years, retiring in 1971. Mrs. Romegialli was a member of Sacred Heart Church in East Berlin and was a former member and the first president of the East Berlin Volunteer Fire Department Auxiliary.
