



Ellsworth H. Carroll

Ellsworth H. Carroll, 94, of New Britain, died on January 12 at the Andrew House. He was born in New Britain, son of the late Edward and Maybell Nafey Carroll. A lifelong resident of New Britain, he attended local schools and had been employed at the Fafnir Bearing Company before retiring in 1974.

For many years he delivered Meals on Wheels in Plainville, New Britain, Bristol and Southington. He was an active member of First Lutheran Church where he served as a trustee and usher.
