



Elsa Carlson Rogerson

October 6, 1910 - July 6, 2002

Elsa Carlson Rogerson, 91, of San Angelo, Texas, formerly of Barbour Road, New Britain, died Saturday July 6, 2002 in San Angelo. She was the widow of Col. Wesley L. Rogerson, U.S. Army retired, who died in 1988. Born in New Britain, she was a long time resident until moving to Texas in 1998. Elsa was employed by SNET in the Engineering Dept. for 32 years until her retirement in 1960. She was a member of First Lutheran Church in New Britain where she taught Sunday School for 25 years. She was also a member of Priscilla Unit, Lutheran Church Women, Swedish Junior League of New Britain and Hartford, and an Associate Member of the Calvary Lutheran Church in San Angelo, Texas.

Surviving is a son, Kurt Rogerson and his wife Cindy of San Angelo, TX; 4 grandchildren, Kristin Rogerson of Daytona Beach, FLA. and Kimberly, Mark, and Rebecca Rogerson all of San Angelo, TX; 2 step grandsons, Daniel W. Rogerson of Jacksonville, FLA. and Robert T. Rogerson of Mount Pleasant, SC; and 4 great granddaughters; Besides her husband Col. Wesley L. Rogerson, she was predeceased by a sister Helen Carlson, and a step son, Howard Rogerson.

Funeral services will be held this Tuesday July 9, 2002 at 11 AM at the Calvary Lutheran Church in San Angelo Texas. A memorial service will be held Friday August 9, 2002 at 12 noon at First Lutheran Church, New Britain. Interment will be in Fairview Cemetery, New Britain.
