Elton L. Abrahamson, 80, of Kensington, beloved husband of Grace Canzonetti Abrahamson, died Monday October 11, 2004 at Ridgeview Health Center in Cromwell. He lived in Kensington since 1951, he was born in New Britain on February 2nd, 1924, son of the late Luther and Agda Johnson Abrahamson. A graduate of New Britain High School, class of 1942, he was a World War II U.S. Army veteran. Elton was a home builder and carpenter with Abrahamson Home Builders for 40 years, retiring in 1986.
