



## Enoch Angelo Passan

May 27, 1924 - May 24, 2016

Enoch Angelo Passan, 91, of New Britain, died at Rapid Recovery Rehabilitation Center in Newington on May 24, 2016 after a long illness. He was the last survivor of a family with four brothers. He was a custodian for the New Britain school system for most of his career and retired as the church sexton in 1989 for St. Mark's Episcopal Church in New Britain after working more than 30 years doing what he loved best. After retirement, he worked for several years as a lot attendant for American Savings Bank, now TD Bank and was valued and loved by all the employees there. For most of his life he remained a faithful born-again Christian, starting out in the former Bethel Church which was part of the Christian and Missionary Alliance.

He leaves behind his beloved wife, Speranza "Sperry" Cinquegrana Passan, his son Kenneth Passan, his daughter-in-law Gayle Passan of Colchester, his daughter Rose Passan McCarthy, his son-in-law Glen McCarthy of Portland, his grandson Jacob McCarthy, and a number of nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by brothers Paul, Rocco and Daniel Passan.

Funeral services are Saturday 11 AM at Carlson Funeral Home 45 Franklin Square, New Britain. Burial will follow in Fairview Cemetery.
