Ernest A. Zick, Sr., 83, formerly of Kensington, died Monday March 10, 2003 at Brittany Farms Health Center, New Britain. Born in New Britain, widower of the late Phyllis Glidden Zick, he lived in Berlin for over 40 years. A graduate of New Britain High School and the Connecticut Institute of Horology, Ernest worked as a watch maker for a number of years and also for the Civilian Conservation Corps. A World War II U.S. Navy veteran, Ernest was a member of Disabled American Veterans and the American Legion. He was also a Charter member of the Prince of Peace Lutheran Church in Kensington. Surviving is a son, Ernest Zick, Jr. and his wife Michelle of North Sutton, NH; a daughter, Joyce Luke and her husband David of East Hampton; a sister-in-law, Irene Domin of New Britain; 4 grandchildren, Diane Chiappetta, David Luke Jr., Jerimiah and Branden Zick; 2 great grandchildren; several nieces and nephews. Besides his wife Phyllis, he was predeceased by 2 brothers, Raymond and Theodore Zick.
