September 15, 1930 - January 13, 2007

Ernestine Moseley Fraprie, 76, of New Britain, the beloved wife of Frank Fraprie, died suddenly and peacefully at home on Saturday January 13, 2007. She was born in Hartford, the daughter of Albert and Ernestine Moseley. She later lived in Farmington and Berlin moving to New Britain in 1947.
