June 25, 1908 - December 21, 2002

Ethel E. Odin, 94, of 975 Corbin Avenue, New Britain, died Saturday Dec. 21, 2002 at the Jerome Home. A native and lifelong New Britain resident, she was the daughter of the late Svening and Hannah Anderson Odin. A graduate of New Britain High School, she received an Associates degree from Connecticut College for Women, her Bachelors Degree from Barnard College in New York City, and her Masters and sixth year certificate from the University of New Hampshire. Miss Odin taught in the English Department at New Britain High School for 41 years, retiring in 1965. She was a member of the South Congregational-First Baptist Church in New Britain; was a former member and friend of the Library, the New Britain Boys & Girls Club Auxiliary, and the New Britain Museum of American Art.

Surviving is a niece, Nancy McIntyre and her husband James of West Hartford; 3 grandnieces, Marcia Klattenberg and her husband Ronald of Middletown; Elizabeth Lomas and her husband Thomas of Old Lyme; and Ms. Laura MacIntyre of Hebron. Besides her parents, she was predeceased by 3 brothers, John, Harold, and Clifford Odin; and a sister, Alma Holmes.
