Floris O. Tinker Dinda, 72, of Alexander Road, New Britain, died Sunday June 3, 2001 at New Britain General Hospital. Wife of Jacob "Jack" Dinda, she was born in Perry-Hill, Maryland, and lived in New Britain since 1931. Floris graduated from New Britain High School in 1946 and was a clerical supervisor at Newington Children's Hospital for 15 years, retiring in 1984. She was a member of the Congregational Church of Plainville, where she sang in the church choir, was a trustee and served on the Music Committee. She attended the Church of Christ, Congregational, in Newington, and she also sang with the New Britain Chorale and in the choir at St. Francis of Assisi Church.
