Frances Manz Kosswig, 84, of New Britain, wife of George W. Kosswig, died Saturday April 13, 2002 surrounded by her family at New Britain General Hospital. A native and lifelong New Britain resident, daughter of the late Joseph and Dora Unwin Manz, she summered at Cedar Lake in Chester for many years. A graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1935, she worked at Burritt Mutual Saving Bank for over 20 years, retiring in 1980. She was a member of South Congregational-First Baptist Church; was an avid cook, baker, and quilter; and in her younger years was active with her children's school PTO's.
