Frances Kirker Varga, 78, of New Britain, died Tuesday December 27, 2005 at Walnut Hill Care Center. She was the widow of Edward Swoszowski, who died in 2000 and of Joseph C. Varga, who died in 1968. Born in Caldwell, New York, she lived in the Stratford-Bridgeport area; then in the Boca Raton, FL area for 19 years, moving to New Britain in 1999. Frances was a teller at the Bridgeport Saving and Loan Bank for 16 years, retiring in 1978. She was a member of the South Congregational-First Baptist Church in New Britain.

Surviving are three sons, Rev. John Varga and his wife Judy of La Canada, CA; Atty's Stephen and Mary Ann Varga of New Britain; and Kirk Varga and his wife Lisa of Laguna Hills, CA; a brother, John Kirker of Glens Falls, New York; a sister, Joan Ross also of Glens Falls; seven grandchildren, Joseph, Elizabeth, Charlotte, Jessica, Katherine, Aiden, and Austin Varga; several nieces and nephews.
