Francis "Frank" Baylock, 72, of South St., New Britain, loving husband of Ruth Jehning Baylock, died Friday July 27, 2001 at his home. A lifelong New Britain resident, he graduated from New Britain High School in 1946 and from Hillyer College, now the University of Hartford. A U.S. Army veteran, he served with the First Cavalry Division during the Korean Conflict. He was a foreman at Emhart Corp. in Berlin retiring 10 years ago after 35 years. An active member of St. Matthew's Lutheran Church, he served as a Trustee, Elder, usher and was former Superintendent of the Sunday School. He was also a member of the church bell choir; the Northwest Veteran's TGM Post; Eddy Glover Post 6, American Legion; and was an avid New Britain Rock Cats fan.
