June 25, 1915 - December 6, 2002

Frank W. Kramer, 87, husband of the late Mary Grzyb Kramer who died in 1985, formerly of Thorniley Street New Britain, died Friday December 6, 2002 surrounded by his family. Mr. Kramer was a graduate of New Britain High School Class of 1934. He served in the US Army during WWII with Battery B of the 232nd Field Artillery Battery. He was employed at Colt Firearms in Hartford for 38 years until his retirement in 1977. He is a member of St. Jerome Church in New Britain, was a player for the former New Britain Emeralds Football Team, and was a member of the 169th Infantry Veterans Corp. Association.
