Frederick C. Stockman, 69, of New Britain, passed away Thursday November 24, 2011 at the Hospital of Central CT in New Britain. A lifelong New Britain resident, Fred is graduate of Gordon College. He served a 21 year career in the Air Force retiring as a Master Sergeant. Fred was also a service officer for the American Legion and the Newington VA and was active with Boys State of the American Legion.
