Frederick Stahl, 96, of 911 Corbin Avenue, New Britain died peacefully in his home on Sunday, October 24, 2010, after a short illness. Frederick was born on August 21, 1914 in New Britain. He was the son of Paul and Elsa Siller Stahl. Frederick was a veteran of WWII and was a S/Sgt. In the Army Air Corps. He worked as a bombsight auto pilot repairman and also worked on the Norden bombsite. After leaving the Army, he worked at the former Landers, Frary & Clark, and then GE. He retired when GE closed. Fred was a member of St. Mark's Episcopal Church and he and his brother Paul sang in the boys choir. Fred loved sailing and won many trophies for his sailing skills.
