George I. Abraham, Sr., 87, of New Britain, widower of Elizabeth "Betty" Sheba Abraham, passed away Tuesday September 2, 2008 at his summer home in Westbrook. A lifelong New Britain resident, he loved having family and friends at his Coral Sands summer home for the past 53 years. A graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1939, George served with the Merchant Marine and the US Army Transport Service during WW II. He retired from Jet Lines Inc. and was a member of the International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 478 for 55 years. George was a lifelong member of the South Church in New Britain and also was a member of Unity Lodge #148, AF&AM.
