George Cherpak, 85, of Southington, husband of Elizabeth "Betty" Kotyk Cherpak, passed away Sunday December 12, 2010 at Hospital of Central Connecticut in New Britain. A New Britain native and long time resident, he moved to Southington in 1997. George was a World War II US Army veteran, and worked at New Britain Machine for twenty years, retiring in 1982. He was a member of St. Mary Ukrainian Orthodox Church in New Britain and was also a member of American Legion Post 72 in Southington and the Disabled American Veterans DAV.
