George A. Ciarcia, 80, of Farmington, husband of Florence “Bunny” Yonan Ciarcia, died Thursday September 23, 2004 at Middlesex Hospital, Middletown. Born in New Haven, he lived in New Britain for 65 years, recently living in Middletown and Farmington. A World War II U.S. Marine Corps veteran, he was a Purple Heart recipient, serving in the Pacific Theatre. George attended New Britain High School, was a graduate of Cheshire Academy and attended Ryder College in New Jersey. He was a former member of the New Britain Elk’s Club; the Knights of Columbus; and the Sons of Italy.

Besides his wife Bunny, he leaves three sons, Peter Ciarcia of Los Angeles, CA; Paul Ciarcia in New York City; and Christopher Ciarcia and his wife Renee of Middletown; a daughter, Diane Ciarcia of Farmington; three granddaughters, Gabrielle, Daphne, and Taylor Ciarcia; a sister in law, Lillian Ciarcia of New Britain; several nieces and nephews.
