George C. Goldfuss, 94, of Middletown, passed away Monday (February 25, 2019) at his home. Born in Mt. Kisco, NY, was a longtime NY resident, moving to New Britain in 2008 and lived in Middletown for the past three years. A World War II US Navy veteran, he was a police officer with the Mt.
