Geza "Jerry" Czako, 82, of Newington, widower of Jean Harriander Czako, passed away Sunday February 10, 2013 at Hospital of Central CT in New Britain. Born in Stamford, he was a former New Britain and Plainville resident, moving to Newington in 1980. An Auto Body Technician, he worked at Grody Chevrolet in West Hartford, Turnpike Motors in Newington and several other area auto body shops, retiring from Maaco in Hartford in 2005.
