



## Gladys Davis Schrager

April 29, 1919 - December 16, 2002

Gladys Rose Davis Schrager, 83, of New Britain, died Monday December 16, 2002 at Hospital for Special Care. She was the widow of Henry H. Schrager, who died in 1971. A lifelong New Britain resident, daughter of the late Arthur and Rose Davis, she worked at the Jerome Home before retiring in 1968. Mrs. Schrager was a member of the First Church of Christ, Congregational in New Britain, where she was a former Sunday School teacher; member of the Women's Fellowship; and Social and Services Group. She was also a former member of Unity Rebekah Lodge.
