Gladys Tuttle Vogt, 93, of New Britain, widow of her beloved husband of 61 years, Earl Vogt, passed away Wednesday August 1, 2012 at the Hospital of Central CT in New Britain. Born in New Britain, daughter of the late Earle and Florence Wright Tuttle, she lived in New Britain and East Haven most of her life. Gladys was a 1936 graduate of the former Commercial High School in New Haven, now Wilbur Cross High School. She was employed at the Traveler's Insurance and later in the Hardware Division and later the corporate headquarters of The Stanley Works for 17 years, retiring in 1984. Gladys was a 60 year active member of the former Trinity United Methodist Church; the Stanley Seniors; the New Britain Senior Citizens; AARP; and the Ladies Auxiliary of Private Walter J. Smith Post, VFW. Gladys enjoyed watching the UConn girls basketball team, spending time with her loving family, traveling, reading, listening to music and going to the beach.
