John M. Glaeser, 84, of New Britain, husband of Diane (Margelot) Glaeser, passed away Saturday (October 2, 2021) at the Hospital of Central CT in New Britain.

Besides his wife Diane, he leaves a daughter, Deborah Kardys of West Granby and her husband Stanley Kardys; two grandsons, Joshua Glaeser of New Britain and Christopher Kardys of West Granby; and several nieces and nephews.

John was born in New Britain, on August 18, 1937 to Arthur and Frances (Corbett) Glaeser. A graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1955, John married Diane, on October 23rd in 1957. John welcomed his daughter Debbie in 1958 and his son Blake in 1961. John worked in the plastics industry in manufacturing at Roland Products, as a systems designer for SNET, and later at Delmar Industries as a plastic designer and international salesman, retiring in 1999. He visited Italy, Mexico, Canada, and parts of the US for his position.

John loved golf, hiking with his family and friends, skiing, and visiting his vacation home in Maine. He was a yearly member of the New Britain Museum of Art and a supporter of the New Britain Industrial Museum. John developed family photo negatives and shared them with family and friends.

He was predeceased by his parents, his brother Arthur E. Glaeser, and this past March by his son, Blake C. Glaeser. John was a member of First Lutheran Church in New Britain.
