



Glenn E. Grimm

Glenn E. Grimm, 87, of Avon, husband of Ann Dyson Grimm, passed away peacefully Sunday June 23, 2013 at home surrounded by his family. Born in Chicago, IL, he was a New Britain resident for more than 20 years before moving to Avon in 1999. Glenn proudly served his country with the US Army's 10th Armored Division in Germany and Austria during WWII and was in such battles as The Battle of The Bulge at the Battle For Bastogne. Glenn was the Vice President of Primeau Argo during the 30 year period that he and his family lived in Toronto, Canada until his retirement in 1980. He was a member of First Church of Christ, Congregational in New Britain and was a former member of the Shuttle Meadow Country Club.

Besides his wife Ann, Glenn leaves behind five children, Peter Grimm and his wife Brenda of Kitchener, Ontario Canada; Susan Weiner and her husband Bruce of Clearwater, FL; Anabel Rylance and her husband James of Mississauga, Ontario Canada; Jonathan Grimm of Toronto, Canada; and Timothy Grimm and his wife Elizabeth of Centerville, MA; six grandchildren; and one brother, Richard H. Grimm of Toronto, Canada. Glenn was predeceased by a brother, Charles Grimm.
