Gloria (Envia) Tuttle, 89, of Newington, passed away Wednesday (May 4, 2022) at the Hospital of Central CT in New Britain. She was the widow of the late Retired Hartford Police Sergeant James D. Tuttle, who died in 1994. Born in Hartford, daughter of Baba and Ossana (Odishoo) Envia, she lived in Newington since 1964. Gloria was a graduate of Buckeley High School in Hartford and started receiving voice lessons in New York City at the age of 14. She sang opera in New York City for 25 years, later was a Paralegal in the Law Firm of Nevens & Nevens in Hartford for 15 years, and then worked at Liberty Mutual Insurance in Rocky Hill for 12 years, retiring in 2011. She was a longtime member of Holy Apostolic Church of the East (St. Thomas) in New Britain.
