



Harold A. Weir

August 5, 1904 - June 18, 2003

Harold A. Weir, 98, of New Britain, died peacefully Thursday June 18, 2003 at Ledgecrest of Kensington. He was the widower of Adele Eggert Weir, who died in 1999. Born in Newington, he lived in New Britain since 1907. A standout athlete and graduate of New Britain High School, class of 1923, he graduated from Troy Conference Academy in Vermont in 1925. Harold worked for Diamond Ginger Ale and later David Masnik, Inc. for 35 years, retiring in 1971. He later worked as a cashier at the New Britain parking garage from 1986 to the early 1990's. He was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church in New Britain; Unity Lodge 148, AF & AM; He was a long time member of the New Britain YMCA, and was a member and former president of the Central Connecticut Association of Football Officials. In 1989 he received the New England Chapter Award from the Football Hall of Fame for 50 years of service as a football official.

He is survived by several nieces and nephews.

Funeral services are Tuesday 1 PM at Kensington United Methodist Church, corner of Church Street and Hotchkiss Street in Kensington with Rev. Richard Griffen officiating.
