Harriet Lyon Blair, 91, of Vernon, died Wednesday January 4, 2006 at Hughes Health Center in West Hartford. She was the widow of Perry Blair, who died in 1998 and was also predeceased by a son, Alan Blair. A native and longtime New Britain resident, she moved to Vernon in 1998. Harriet graduated from New Britain High School in 1932 and worked in the purchasing department of Stanley Works for over 25 years, retiring in 1976.
