



## Harry Furdas

April 24, 1920 - September 30, 2010

Harry Furdas, 90, of New Britain, widower of Anna Pasternak Furdas, passed away Thursday September 30, 2010. Born in The Ukraine, in 1942, he was taken to a German Labor camp. After the war, he worked in a coal mine in LaBourse, France for 8 years. Harry came to New Britain in 1952. He was employed at the Fafnir Bearing Company in New Britain, retiring in 1983, and was a member of St. Mary Ukrainian Orthodox Church in New Britain.

Surviving is a son, Robert Furdas and his wife Sharon of New Britain; a daughter, Vera Furdas-Drobka and her husband Joseph Drobka of Hartford; three grandchildren, Gregory Furdas and his wife Lisa of Greensboro, NC; Patricia Mokritski and her husband Kenneth of Newington; and Robert A. Furdas of New Britain; four great grandchildren, Robert and Ashley Garbalosa, Michael and Kara Furdas.
