Helen Bowers Dodson, 91, of Berlin, died Thursday April 15, 2004 at her home. She was the widow of John W. Dodson, who died in 1984. Born in Middletown, Helen was employed at Emhart Corporation and later Black & Decker in Berlin. She was a member of St. Gabriels Episcopal Church in East Berlin, serving as church organist and choir director for many years. She also served on the Altar Guild at the church, and was a member of the Berlin Historical Society and a Board Member Emeritus at Wilcox Cemetery Association.

Surviving is a brother, Richard Bowers and his wife Lorraine of Dallas, Texas; several nieces and nephews. She was predeceased by a brother, Ralph Bowers and a sister, Esther Bowers.
