



## Henry A. Dyson

November 15, 1926 - May 5, 2021

Henry A. Dyson, 94, of Kensington, husband of Joyce (Brock) Dyson, passed away Wednesday (May 5, 2021) at home, surrounded by his family. He was a loving, kind and generous husband, father, grandfather, uncle and friend to all he knew. Born in New Britain on Nov 15, 1926, son of the late Eugene and Bessie (Beach) Dyson, Henry and Joyce lived in New Britain for many years before moving to Kensington. A graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1945, he served with the Seabees in the U.S. Navy at the end of World War II. Henry was a graduate of TriState University, now Trine University in Angola, Indiana with a degree in Mechanical Engineering. He was employed as Sales Manager at the former Tuttle & Bailey Company in New Britain for over 20 years, and later owned Dyson Associates for 25 years until his retirement in 2001. Henry was a member of Kensington Congregational Church; the Shuttle Meadow Country Club; and the Round Table. He was a Past Master of Walnut Hill Lodge 139, AF&AM, now Unity Lodge; he was a 32nd degree Scottish Right Mason and was a member of Sphinx Temple Shrine and its Motor Patrol and the Jesters.
