Herbert C. Lindberg, 81, of Newington, died Friday January 3, 2002 at Hartford Hospital. Born in Farmington, he lived in New Britain until moving to Newington in 1952. A graduate of New Britain High School and EC Goodwin Technical School, he received his Bachelor's Degree from Hillyer College in Hartford. A World War II US Navy veteran, he was employed at Stanadyne in Windsor for 36 years, retiring as Chief Engineer in 1985. Herb was a member of First Lutheran Church in New Britain; SVEA Social club; was a life member of SME Society of Manufacturing Engineers, for whom he contributed many written technical articles; was a past Commander of the Wethersfield VFW Post; was also past State Commander of the VFW; and was formerly active with the Elizabeth Green Elementary School PTA in Newington. He was also a 50 year Mason.

Surviving is his wife Sophie "Sue" Russin Lindberg; 2 sons, Bruce Lindberg of New Britain and Paul Lindberg of Newington; a daughter, Joyce O'Dea and her husband Kerry of West Hartford; a sister, Dorothy Lindberg of New Britain; 2 grandchildren, Analise and Michael O'Dea; several nieces and nephews.
