Herman F. Simonides, 88, of New Britain, devoted and loving husband, father and grandfather, passed away Monday Sept 15, 2008 at the Hospital of Central CT in New Britain. A native and lifelong New Britain resident, he was son of the late John and Susanna Wawrinsky Simonides. Herman was a graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1938 and served with the US Army Air Corps during World War II. He was employed at Fafnir Bearing Company for 42 years, retiring in 1982.
