



Hildur Carlsson Wennberg

March 19, 1908 - March 20, 2004

Hildur Carlsson Wennberg, 96, of New Britain, died Saturday March 20, 2004 at New Britain General Hospital. Hildur was born in Sunne, Sweden in 1908, and in 1927, Hildur, as a teenager seeking opportunity and adventure, joined the mass immigration to these shores fortified with determination and three words of English, "Train to Providence?". Later she relocated to Hartford which she thought to be the most beautiful city she has ever seen. There she met and married S. Harry Wennberg, another Swedish native. They settled in New Britain and raised two sons who became as bilingual as their parents and learned an appreciation for their ethnic heritage. S. Harry Wennberg passed away in 1958 and Hildur has lived independently ever since. She was a member of First Lutheran Church in New Britain; and the Tegner-Valkyrian Lodge, Order of Vasa.

Surviving are her two sons, Harry O. Wennberg and his wife Beverly of Southington and Walter S. Wennberg and his wife Mary Morse of Marlborough; a granddaughter, Tracy Somers and her husband Doug of Southington; and two dearly beloved great grandsons, Kyle and Glen Somers. Besides her husband S. Harry Wennberg, she was predeceased by a brother Sven Carlson.

A memorial service will be held Saturday April 17, 2004 10 AM at First Lutheran Church, 77 Franklin Square, New Britain. Burial will be in the Carlsson family plot in Sunne, Varmland, Sweden. There are no calling hours. Donations may be made to the First Lutheran Church Memorial Fund. Carlson
