



## Howard K. Bowman

May 11, 1935 - January 30, 2008

Howard K. Bowman, 72, of Southington passed away Wednesday January 30, 2008. He was born on May 11, 1935, the son of the late Dorothy Kelsey Bowman and Harry F. Bowman of Wethersfield. Howard graduated from Wethersfield High School and Boston University, and lived in Southington since 1967. He was employed by VanZelm, Heywood & Shadford for many years and later on by the Hungerford Nature Center and Consulting Engineers Services. He was an active member of the First Congregational Church of Southington since 1967 and a longtime member of the choir. He was an avid photographer and was the former president of the Country Camera Club. Howard also belonged to the Meriden and Charter Oak Camera Clubs as well as a longtime member of the New England Camera Club Council and its Model Committee. Additionally, he was president of the Kelsey Kindred and was a member of the Wethersfield Senior Duckpin Bowling League. Howard is survived by his wife of 41 years, Nancy Person Bowman of Southington; two daughters, Lori Stein and her husband Kevin of Milford, and Melanie Brodsky and her husband Eric of Holbrook, NY; a son, Keith Bowman and his wife Andrea of Avon; four grandchildren, Tyler and Alexandra Stein, and Griffin and Lilyanna Bowman. He is also survived by a brother, Robert F. Bowman of Wethersfield.

Funeral services will be held Saturday 10 AM at the First Congregational Church of Southington, 37 Main Street, Southington. Calling hours are Friday 4 to 6PM at Carlson Funeral Home, 45 Franklin Sq., New Britain. Burial will be
