Howard D. Olson, 83, of Southington, husband of Florette Boissoneau Olson, died Saturday January 24, 2004 at Bradley Memorial Hospital. A native and former New Britain resident, he lived in Southington since 1969. A World War II U.S. Army veteran, Howard worked at New Britain Machine Company for 24 years and later at Royal Machine in Berlin, retiring in 1989.
