



Iola Sahrbacker Morley

February 10, 1915 - March 3, 2008

Iola Sahrbacker Morley, 93, lifelong New Britain resident, wife of Milton Morley, died Monday March 3, 2008 at Avery Heights in Hartford. Iola is a graduate of New Britain High School class of 1932, and Mary Hitchcock Memorial School of Nursing in Hanover, NH in 1936. Iola devoted much of her work time to nursing positions at area clinics and hospitals including New Haven Hospital, Hartford Hospital, New Britain General Hospital, Grove Hill Clinic, and was also industrial nurse at Fafnir Bearing Company. She also did 35 years of volunteer service for the American Red Cross. She was a member of the New Britain Women's Club, Mary Hitchcock Alumnae Association, and also St. Mark's Episcopal Church. At St. Mark's, Iola was the Superintendent of Sunday School, Past President of the Episcopal Churchwomen, member of the Vestry, and a member of the choir.

Besides her husband Milton, Iola is survived by a son, Richard Morley and his wife Victoria of Newington; two grandchildren, Kevin Morley of Methuen, MA; and Jennifer Wrona and her husband Tim of Philadelphia, PA; and a sister-in-law, Helen Sahrbacker of Parma, Ohio. She was predeceased by a brother, Edward Sahrbacker.

Funeral services will be held Friday 10 AM at St. Mark's Episcopal Church 147 West Main Street, New Britain. Burial will follow in Fairview Cemetery. There are no calling hours.
