Irene Dougherty Greenhalgh, 90, of New Britain, widow of Milton Greenhalgh, died Wednesday June 13, 2007 at Jerome Home, New Britain. A lifelong New Britain resident, she was daughter of the late Daniel and Mary Kerrigan Dougherty. Irene graduated from New Britain High School in 1934, and was employed in the Finance Department of the City of New Britain for 20 years, retiring in 1974. She was a member of St. Maurice Church and the Women's Auxiliary of the New Britain Salvation Army. Irene was a former volunteer for the New Britain Red Cross and the Jerome Home.

Surviving are two brothers, Robert Dougherty of Dover-Foxcroft, Maine and Daniel Dougherty of Southington; a special sister-in-law and caregiver, Annette Dougherty of New Britain; another sister-in-law, Mary Dougherty of Berlin; several nieces and nephews. She was predeceased by three brothers, Charles Dougherty, James Dougherty and William Dougherty.
