Irene Grant Yukins, 101, of Farmington, wife of the late Joseph E. Yukins, passed away Thursday February 9, 2012 at The Reservoir Health Care & Rehab Center in West Hartford. She lived in New Britain since 1954 and was the daughter of the late Hiram Coleman and Jessie Currie Grant of Rockland, MA. Graduate of Waterville High School, Waterville, Maine, she attended Posse-Nissen School of Physical Education in Boston, MA.
