Italia Saccoccio Alfieri, 97, of New Britain, widow of Louis J. Alfieri, passed away Wednesday October 1, 2008 at Walnut Hill Care Center in New Britain. Born in Roccomonfine, Italy, Italia has been a New Britain resident since 1929. She was employed at Trumbull Electric in Plainville for 15 years, and later The Outlet Store for 10 years until her retirement in 1973. Italia was a member of St. Ann's Church in New Britain; and volunteered at the Hospital for Special Care Thrift Shop for 26 years.
