J. Edwin Halverson, 91, of New Britain, died Wednesday February 9, 2005 at Brittany Farms Health Care Center. He was the widower of Nancy Magnuson Halverson, who died in 1992. A native and lifelong New Britain resident, Ed was a World War II U.S. Army Veteran serving in the 34th Infantry Division in both North Africa and Italy. He operated Halverson & Sons Moving Company for 10 years after the war, worked for Smedley Movers for 10 years and later worked for the New Britain Gas Light Company and Connecticut Natural Gas, retiring in 1978. He was a member of First Lutheran Church; the SVEA Social Club; and the American Legion Post in Rocky Hill. Prior to the war, he sang with Ardi Sextet Singing Group, and following the war, he sang with the Wennerberg Male Chorus for many years.

Surviving are two sons, Mark Halverson and his wife Susan of Belle Mead, NJ; and John L. Halverson of New Britain; four grandchildren, Timothy Halverson of Cape May, NJ; Melissa Halverson of Brooklyn, NY; Crystal Halverson of Belle Mead, NJ; and Jessica Halverson of New Britain; as well as several nieces and nephews.

Funeral services are Monday 1 PM at Carlson Funeral Home, 45 Franklin Square, New Britain. Burial with military honors is in Fairview Cemetery.
