Jack Baba, 86, of Plainville, widower of Viola Tamaraz Baba, passed away Friday December 5, 2008 at Farmington Care Center. Born in New Britain, son of the late Peter and Alice Zaya Baba, he lived in Plainville since 1964. A graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1940, he served with the US Navy during World War II. Jack was employed at GE in Plainville for 30 years and then at Fafnir Bearing company for 10 years, retiring in 1986. He was a member of St. Thomas Assyrian Church of the East in New Britain and was a past president of the Assyrian American National Federation.
