Janet Clayton, 50, of Durham, died Monday September 3, 2007 at Hartford Hospital from injuries received in an auto accident in Durham. Born in New Britain, she was a former resident of Newington, Cheshire and Meriden before moving to Durham. A graduate of Newington High School, Class of 1975, she also attended Manchester Community College. Janet was a former Secretary at First Lutheran Church in New Britain and also worked at Walmart. She ran her own dog grooming business in Meriden for a number of years.

Surviving are her parents, Ralph and Anna Soderquist Clayton of Venice, FL; a brother, David Clayton and his wife Nancy of Port Orange, FL; two sisters, Susan Alessi and her husband Steven of Berlin; and Anne Marie Walsh and her husband Jay of Montgomery, NY; five nieces and two nephews, Brittany and Christopher Walsh; Adrianna, Lizzy and Andrew Alessi; Celine and Deanna Clayton; an uncle and several aunts including Sylvia Herberts and Barbara Clayton; many cousins; and her adored dogs, Molly and Billie.
