Jean Controvellos Mangan, 59, of Newington, wife of Charles B. Mangan, died Tuesday April 10, 2007 at home surrounded by her family. Born in New Britain, she is a graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1965 and has been a Newington resident since 1970. She was employed by the Town of Newington for 30 years, serving the last 22 years as Revenue Collector. She is a member of First Church of Christ Congregational in New Britain serving on many committees; a member and former officer of the Connecticut Tax Collectors Association; held three positions with the North East Regional Tax Collectors and Treasurers Association; and was a member of the Newington Women's Club and the DAV Auxiliary.

Besides her husband Charles, she leaves two sons, Scott Mangan and his wife Kristine of Newington; and Shawn Mangan and his wife Tracy-Lee also of Newington; a sister, Audrey Ann Braholli of Canton, Ohio; six grandchildren, Aaron, Nicholas, Michael, Sarah, John and Hannah Mangan; a special aunt and uncle, Charles and Florence Innes of Farmington; close and special friends, Joey and Joan Belanger of Newington; several nieces and nephews.
