Jeffrey T. Weber, 74, of New Britain, passed away Thursday (December 8, 2022) at the Hospital of Central CT in New Britain. A New Britain native and longtime resident, he was son of the late Charles and Dorothy “Dot” (Heslin) Weber. Jeff was a graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1968 and proudly served with the US Army during the Vietnam War.
