Jerillyn "Jerri" Fulvio Massi, 63, of Plantsville, wife of Dr. James Massi, passed away Wednesday May 14, 2008 at her home. Born in Upper Darby, PA, she was daughter of Monica Hewitt Fulvio of West Chester, PA and the late Albert Fulvio. Jerri lived in New Britain for 30 years, moving to Plantsville a year and a half ago. A graduate of Immacuata College in Pennsylvania in 1966, she was President of Manes & Motions Therapeutic Riding Center, a member program of the Hospital for Special Care in New Britain since she founded it in 1999. She was a member and Eucharistic Minister of St. Dominic Church in Southington and was a sustaining member and past president of the Junior League of Greater New Britain.

Besides her husband and mother, she leaves two daughters, Maria Dakake and her husband David of Burke, VA; and Joanne Humen and her husband Michael of Kensington; two sons, Leonard Massi and his wife Raquel of Tamarac, FL and Gregory Massi of Arlington, MA; a brother, Albert Fulvio and his wife Patricia of Quarryville, PA; seven grandchildren, Gabriel and Nuria Dakake; Alex, Stephanie and Nadia Humen; Tristano and Maverick Massi; and four nephews.

Funeral services are Monday 9 AM at Carlson Funeral Home, 45 Franklin Square, New Britain followed by a Mass of Christian Burial 10 AM at St. Dominic Church, 1050 Flanders Road, Southington.
